For the second year, CPAC and the Denver Botanic Gardens are jointly sponsoring Family Portrait Day, a fundraiser to support operating costs at both organizations.

Family Portrait Day offers families the chance to have their portrait taken by a professional photographer of their choice in one of the Gardens most scenic areas.

"Each family will enjoy a 30-minute photo session, at their chosen location with one of the region's most celebrated portrait photographers," said event chair Monique Crine. "The full access to reproduction that comes with each package can represent a significant savings to each family, when compared to having a portrait session taken at a more traditional outlet. Plus, every session represents support for our youth programming."

Groups of up to 8 people will enjoy a 30 minute photo session, and will receive 12-15 high-resolution images chosen by their photographer. Packages come with full permission to reproduce images as many times and in whatever formats a family chooses.

Tin-type customers will also have the educational benefit of watching their tin-types created while they wait. Tin-type photos can be scheduled in advance on the CPAC website or conducted on a drop-in basis. \$250 portrait sessions must be booked in advance.
